The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of restrictions due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioner-Dalbir Singh, stated to be aged 45 years, has filed the present Revision Petition *inter alia* with a prayer for setting aside the order dated 31.01.2020 (Annexure P-9), passed by the learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Faridabad, in case of Execution No.2393 of 2014 dated 08.03.2013 titled as Dalbir Singh vs. Inder Singh, pending for 05.09.2020, whereby, the petitioner is directed to affix the stamp paper on the execution of sale deed in violation of the earlier order dated 07.09.2019 (Annexure P-7), passed by the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that order dated 31.01.2020, has fallen to error as the earlier order dated 07.09.2019, passed by the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Faridabad, has not been taken into consideration, while passing the order dated 31.01.2020. On a question

put by this court, as to whether the order dated 07.09.2019 was brought to the notice of the Court, which passed the order dated 31.01.2020, learned counsel for the petitioner has not been able to specifically say as to if the order was brought to the notice of the Court or not.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner makes an oral request that he would now move an application before the Learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Faridabad, which passed the order dated 31.01.2020, to take into consideration order dated 07.09.2019 and inter alia other submissions that he wish to make in the application.

Request is accepted.

In view of the above, the present Civil Revision is **disposed of** with a direction to the Presiding Officer/Link Court of Civil Judge (Senior Division) Faridabad, to decide the application, which the petitioner intends to file, within a period of one month from the date of filing of the application.
