1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition under Sections 10 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, is for taking action against the respondents for deliberately and willfully disobeying order (Annexure P-1) dated 30.09.2019, passed in CWP No.25369 of 2018.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Karan Singla, Advocate, who is present in Court, on the asking of the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and on the basis of instructions from respondent No.1, states that order of this Court (Annexure P-1), dated 30.09.2019, passed in CWP No.25369 of 2018 has been complied with by passing order dated 24.06.2020 and that said orders would be communicated to the petitioners *via* e-mail, as well as registered post within 01 week from today.

6. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the parties, the contempt petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.1 to transmit copy of order dated 24.06.2020, passed in compliance of order (Annexure P-1), dated 30.09.2019, in CWP No.25369 of 2018, to the petitioners *via* e-mail, as well as registered post within a period of 01 week from today.

7. Contempt petition is disposed of, as not calling for any further orders. However, it is made clear that in case order of this Court as stated above is not complied with, it would be open to the petitioners to move an application for restoration of the contempt petition.
