Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.138 dated 06.08.2020 under Sections 21, 29 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station City South Moga, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, the police recovered 20 grams of heroin from co-accused Mani and on the basis of his disclosure statement, the petitioner has been nominated as a person, from whom he has acquired the narcotic. It is further submitted that in fact, brother of the petitioner namely Jagdev Singh had solemnized marriage with one Prachi Gupta and he has obtained protection from this Court and said Jagdev Singh, who is also accused in an NDPS case, was also granted bail by this Court and on that account, the petitioner has been implicated in the present case.

Learned State counsel has, however, submitted that the order in the protection petition was passed on 27.07.2020, whereas much prior to that, the petitioner is involved in as many as 12 FIRs, detail of which is given in the order passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, dismissing his application for bail and all these FIRs are prior to this date.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, without commenting anything on merits of the case and looking into the antecedents of the petitioner, who is repeatedly involved in number of cases since long, I find no ground to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
