This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail pending trial in FIR No.19 dated 16.02.2020 under Section 379-A IPC, registered at Police Station GRP, District Hisar.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

FIR came to be registered on the complaint of one Ravi Soni. Complainant asserted that on 14.02.2020 while he was going from Delhi to Bhattu Kalan on Sirsa Express train then at about 11.00 p.m. when the train reached at Hisar railway station, one young boy was seated on the window seat in front of him who snatched away his mobile phone make Samsung Galaxy-A-30 and jumped from the running train.

Petitioner herein was arrested on 17.06.2020.

As per prosecution version the petitioner is the one who had snatched the phone and subsequently made an attempt to sell the phone for Rs.8,000/- to one Yoginder. Yoginder having demanded the original bill

of the phone and the petitioner being unable to do the same, the phone was returned as also the sale consideration amount.

Investigation in the case is complete and the challan has been presented. Trial is at the very initial stage and would take time to conclude.

Petitioner is not stated to be involved in any other criminal proceedings and as such has clean antecedents.

This Court also take note of a certificate placed on record at Annexure P-2 reflecting the petitioner to be suffering from the Orthopedically Disability i.e. right lower limb deformity.

Without making any observation on merit, petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of bail.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
