Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

By way of the present petition, the petitioner seeks directions to the official respondents to fairly investigate the representations dated 30.06.2020 and 23.07.2020 (Annexures P.1 and P.2) made by the petitioners to the official respondents, against respondent Nos.4 to 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the petitioner had submitted a complaint dated 30.06.2020 to respondent No.3, yet no FIR has been registered till date. It is further submitted that subsequent thereafter, the petitioner had submitted another representation dated 23.07.2020 to respondent No.2, but the same did also not yield any result.

The petitioner is aggrieved against the inaction on the part of the police authorities. In view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in M. Subramaniam and another Vs. S. Janaki and another, 2020(2) RCR (Criminal) 788, in case of non registration of an FIR, the remedy of the petitioner is not to approach this Court, but she is at liberty to approach the Magistrate concerned under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to avail her remedy in accordance with the judgment in M. Subramaniam's case (supra).
