While deciding the appeal on 08.11.2006, the directions were issued by this Court and the compliance report was sought from the concerned office. The relevant paragraph of the above said order reads as under:-

“It would have been in the fitness of thing to prosecute at least Gurmej Singh Inspector-SHO. If he was not in the party and did not commit offences of dacoity then he was liable for showing himself as In charge of the party, which committed such serious offences. Under these circumstances, it is directed that Home Secretary, Punjab/DGP, Punjab shall look into the matter and take steps to prosecute Gurmej Singh Inspector at least for the offences for which Sanjeev Kumar appellant had been charged or at least for preparing false documents involving Sukhraj Singh and keeping him wrongfully confined.”

As the compliance report was not received, therefore, the case was placed before this Court in that regard. Mr. Sabharwal, Advocate has

produced copy of the judgment dated 28.04.2009 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Criminal Appeal No.992-2009 filed by Gurmej Singh whereby appeal carried by the concerned officer against the said direction was allowed vide order dated 28.04.2009.

Since the direction dated 08.11.2006 is no more in existence, therefore, the compliance part of the said order is rendered infructuous.

Disposed off.
