The instant petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari against respondent Nos. 1 and 2 to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 25.08.2020 praying cancellation of impugned transfer order dated 25.08.2020 whereby the petitioner has been transferred in violation of the Transfer Policy dated 23.04.2018.

It is contended that the petitioner, being a lady officer, has been transferred twice beyond 150 kilometers despite having made various representations from time to time. Learned counsel for the petitioner urges that the representation dated 25.08.2020 should be decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, on the asking of the Court, Ms. Anju Sharma Kaushik, DAG, Punjab appearing through the mode of video conferencing accepts notice on behalf of all the respondents and submits that official respondents will look into the matter and decide the representation of the petitioner.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing respondents Nos 1 and 2 to decide the representation dated 25.08.2020 (Annexure P-6) of the petitioner within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

Until the passing of fresh order as aforesaid, the impugned transfer order dated 25.08.2020 shall be kept in abeyance qua the petitioner.
