Petitioners claim that they have attained majority and married against the wishes of their family members. Apprehending threat to their life and liberty, they have filed the present petition for protection.

Petitioners claim to have submitted a representation (Annexure P-6) dated 27.8.2020 in this regard to the Senior Superintendent of Police, S.B.S. Nagar.

Heard. Record perused.

Notice of motion to the office of Advocate General, Punjab.

On asking of the Court, Mr. M.S. Nagra, Assistant A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

The petitioner No.1 has placed on record copies of her Aadhar Card and School Leaving Certificate (Annexures P-1 and P-2), similarly,

petitioner No.2 has placed on record copy of his Aadhar Card (Annexure P-3) as proof of their age as well as copy of Marriage Certificate (Annexure P-4) regarding performance of marriage.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 - S.H.O., Police Station Sadar Nawanshahr, District SBS Nagar, that representation, if any, filed seeking protection of life and liberty, be looked into and contents thereof be duly verified and if necessary, requisite steps be taken, strictly in accordance with law for grant of protection of life and liberty to the petitioners. It is made clear that this order shall not be treated as a stamp of this Court regarding marriage of the parties.
