By this petition, the petitioners are praying for quashing of the Rapat/General Diary Details No. 002 dated 14.05.2020 for offence under Section 323 IPC registered at Police Station, Kartarpur, District Jalandhar (Annexure P-1) registered in FIR No. 0095 dated 13.05.2020 for offence under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149 of IPC and Sections 326 and 307 of IPC were added later on, registered at Police Station, Kartarpur, District Jalandhar (Annexure P-2) on the basis of compromise dated 22.06.2020 (Annexure P-3) and all the other consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioners refers to order dated 01.09.2020 passed in CRM-M-25472-2020 whereby FIR No. 0095 dated 13.05.2020 has been quashed on the basis of compromise dated 22.06.2020 (Annexure P-3). He further states that in the present case, on the basis of a compromise, Rapat/General Diary Details No. 002 dated 14.05.2020 (Annexure P-1) be also quashed.

Mr. M.S. Dullat, Additional Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent No. 1 and Mr. Anil Kumar Sepahiya, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 2 to 9.

Learned counsel for the State is also not disputing the compromise and quashing of afore-stated FIR.

Keeping in view above fact, petition is allowed and the Rapat/General Diary Details No. 002 dated 14.05.2020 alongwith all the other consequential proceedings arising therefrom is also quashed.
