The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in this writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of writ, order or direction, including a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to release the amount deposited by the petitioners towards contributory provident fund along with interest accrued thereon.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that at this stage, petitioners would be satisfied in case the Director General of Police, Punjab, Police Headquarter Sector 9, Chandigarh i.e. respondent No.2 is directed to decide the legal notice dated 03.03.2020 (Annexure P-5) in a time bound manner.

At this stage, Mr. T.P.S. Chawla, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents-State.

Heard.

Without adverting to the claim of the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2-Director General of Police, Punjab, Police Headquarter Sector 9, Chandigarh, to consider the prayer of the petitioners so projected in the legal notice (Annexure P-5) dated 03.03.2020 and to take final decision thereon within a period of 6 month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
