Case taken up through video conferencing.

By way of filing the present civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners Balwinder Singh and others crave for issuance of a direction to the respondents, especially respondents No.4 and 5 to get the land demarcated through which natural water is to flow to the land of petitioners as per the approved site plan of the area prepared by the Revenue Department, Punjab and further praying for issuance of direction to respondent No.6 to provide necessary police help to respondent No.5 for carrying out the demarcation at the site in village Kot Bhai – 2, Tehsil Gidderbaha, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

The petitioners are said to have submitted several representations to the respondents before filing of the petition without evoking any positive response.

Heard.

Under the circumstances, the present petition is disposed of directing respondent No.2 – Deputy Commissioner, Sri Muktsar Sahib to look into the representation Annexure P6 moved by petitioner No.1 and to get the demarcation conducted, if it is not impractical or otherwise barred under the law, from the competent revenue authorities, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of copy of this order in his office.
