1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is for initiating action against the respondent for intentionally, deliberately and willfully disobeying order (Annexure P-1) dated 10.07.2020 in CRM-M No.18074 of 2020 in case titled as '**Rajinder Singh**versus**State of Haryana and others.**'

3. Learned counsel contends that vide order (Annexure P-1) dated 10.07.2020, CRM-M No.18074 of 2020 was disposed of by directing the Superintendent of Police, Jind, District Jind, to get representation dated 21.06.2020, submitted by the petitioner, examined from some senior officer, expeditiously, in accordance with law and in case, the allegations levelled therein were found to be well founded, to take necessary steps warranted under law in respect thereto at the earliest but despite lapse of sufficient period of time, needful has not been done.

4. Learned State Counsel has referred to order (Annexure R-2) dated 21.08.2020, passed by the respondent, dismissing representation dated 21.06.2020, submitted by the petitioner on account of the same being devoid of merit.

5. Copy of the reply has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal of the same states that in the circumstances, he does not press the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of as such, with liberty to challenge order (Annexure R-2) dated 21.08.2020, passed by the respondent before appropriate forum, in accordance with law.

6. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the Contempt Petition is ***disposed of*** as not pressed with the liberty, as prayed for.
