It has been stated that respondent No.4 is the husband of the petitioner and on account of matrimonial dispute, the petitioner was given beating and turned out of her matrimonial home. Even the parental family of the petitioner has refused to rehabilitate her and she is presently residing in the house of her acquaintance namely Mukesh Kumar S/o Ishwar Singh R/o Village Jodhkan, District Sirsa. The petitioner is apprehending danger to her life and liberty at the instance of respondent No.4 and has already submitted a representation dated 22.08.2020 (Annexure P-1) to respondent No.2.
