Case has been heard through video conferencing on account of COVID-19 Pandemic.

Learned State counsel, at the outset, submits that FIR in this case has been registered and in this regard, reply was filed on the last date of hearing. On this, counsel for the petitioner submits that he has restricted his relief for providing protection to the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.5 to 7, who are time and again, threatening him with dire consequences.

Counsel for the petitioner further submits that he be also given liberty to seek remedy with regard to non-registration of the FIR against respondents No.5 to 7 under Sections 452 and 307 IPC.

In the light of the aforesaid, this petition is hereby disposed of with aforesaid liberty to the petitioner for seeking appropriate remedy under the law, with further liberty to him to approach respondent No.3 to seek protection to his life and liberty in case he is having any threat perception from anyone including respondents No.5 to 7.
