The petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in a criminal case arising from FIR No.183 dated 30.07.2020, registered under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914, at Police Station Dhariwal District Gurdaspur.

As per the case of the prosecution, although, the petitioner ran away from spot on seeing the police party, however, 30 bottles of illegal liquor was recovered. As per the order passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur while dismissing an application for pre-arrest bail of the petitioner, it has been noticed that the petitioner is involved in as many as 5 more similar cases under the Punjab Excise Act, 1914.

In view thereof, there is no ground to grant pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.
