This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of the pandemic, COVID-19.

The petitioner, is aggrieved by the action of respondents, in not releasing the payment, stated to be due to it, for the work allegedly executed to the satisfaction of the respondents. It is submitted that despite legal notice dated 27.07.2020 (Annexure P-3), no action has been taken.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, seeks a limited relief to the extent that legal notice dated 27.07.2020 (Annexure P-3), served upon the respondents by the petitioner, be decided in a time bound manner.

Ms. Anju Sharma Kaushik, DAG., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents no.1 and 2. Advance copy of the petition stands served.

Mr. Parambir Singh, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondents no 3 to 5.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and the limited prayer addressed, but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to decide legal notice dated 27.07.2020 (Annexure P-3), within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Needless to say, the amount, if any, found to be due towards the petitioner, shall be released within four weeks thereafter.
