1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has submitted representations Annexure P/12 dated 24.08.2017, Annexure P/16 dated 22.03.2018 and Annexure P/20 dated 30.07.2020, but the same have not been decided till date and that in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation Annexure P/20 dated 30.07.2020, in accordance with law.
3. Notice of motion to respondent No.2 only.
4. Mr. Vivek Chauhan, Addl. AG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2 and states that he has no objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, except bringing to the notice of this Court that the writ petition is highly belated.
5. Without commenting upon the merits of the controversy or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the writ petition is disposed

of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation Annexure P/20 dated 30.07.2020, in accordance with law, after taking into account all aspects of the matter, as expeditiously as possible.

6. Writ petition disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
