This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been moved for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to take legal action against respondent No.4 who after stealing the car of petitioner has beaten him with the help of hooligans on gun point with further direction to respondent No.3 to recover the car of petitioner bearing registration No.PB-11-CS-5874.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representations dated 29.11.2019 and 28.02.2020 to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, copies of which are available on the file as Annexures P/3 and P/4 respectively, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. M.S. Nagra, Assistant Advocate

General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, to look into and decide representations dated 29.11.2019 and 28.02.2020 (Annexures P/3 and P/4) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within six weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
