GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of the restrictions due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioners-Joginder Kumar and three others, have jointly filed the present petition *inter alia* praying for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.102 dated 15.05.2020 under Sections 323, 324, 326, 307, 148, 149, 427, 506, 120-B IPC and Section 54 of Disaster Management Act, 2005, registered at Police Station Shimlapuri, Ludhiana.

Vide order dated 03.09.2020, the petitioners were granted interim bail and directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Dilbagh Singh, states that the petitioners have joined investigation and their custodial interrogation is no more required.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. The order dated

03.09.2020 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioners, is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr. P.C.
