The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to take strict action against respondents No.4 to 6 for illegally involving the petitioner in a false and frivolous case against his wife respondent No.7 who is illegally detained by respondents No.4 to 6.

Pursuant to the order dated 02.09.2020, respondent No.7- Amandeep Kaur is present before the Court through video conferencing and when she was interacted by this Court, she is very specific that she is not inclined to stay with the petitioner.

Even otherwise, short reply by way of affidavit of Gurjit Singh Romana, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, City-1, Bathinda, has been filed on behalf of respondent No.3 which is accompanied with the statement of respondent No.7-Amandeep Kaur daughter of Resham Singh. The reply shows that in the statement made on behalf of respondent No.7, she has categorically stated that presently she is residing with her parents of her own accord and free will and has not been detained by anyone forcibly. She has also stated that she has filed a complaint against the petitioner with the police, which is pending.

Faced with the reply which is accompanied with the statement of respondent No.7, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of present petition so as to avail the remedy as available under law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
