The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 254 dated 21.08.2020 registered under Sections 195-A, 506, 34 IPC at Police Station Kasola, District Rewari.

The operative part of the order dated 02.09.2020, vide which the petitioners have been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Counsel for the petitioners has argued that there are previous FIRs pending between the parties and the allegation in the present FIR is that the petitioners have threatened the complainant to compromise the matter or face the serious consequences. It is further argued that in fact, the petitioners' side is the complainant in an FIR registered under Section 307 IPC against the complainant in the present FIR.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners, in pursuance to the order dated 02.09.2020, have already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and have joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners, vide order dated 02.09.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
