The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 10 dated 21.2.2020, registered under Section 306 IPC, at Police Station Sadar Jalalabad, District Fazilka.

It is submitted by the counsel for the petitioners that the case against the petitioners is totally concocted. Still further, it is submitted that the petitioners were not required to transfer any land in favour of the brother of petitioner No.1. It was to be transferred, if any, only by their father. Father has already been granted bail by the trial Court.

Notice of motion.

Mr. APS Gill, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

The counsel for the State, being instructed by ASI Malook Singh, has submitted that, in fact, the police have already prepared the cancellation

report qua the FIR in question and are in the process of filing the same. Therefore, the police do not have any plan to arrest the petitioners.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed. It is ordered that the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when so required by the Investigating Agency. However, in case of arrest, the Investigating Officer is directed to release the petitioners on bail on their furnishing bail bonds/surety to his satisfaction. It is further directed that the petitioners shall also observe the other conditions as required under Section 438(2) of Cr.P.C.
