1. Case is being taken up for hearing through VideoConferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Learned counsel contends that claim of the petitioner for re-engagement as Asstt. Professor/Extension Lecturer (Chemistry), in terms of policy Annexure P/5 dated 04.03.2020, has not been considered and decided till date, despite lapse of period much more than the period of one week as contemplated under the policy.
3. Learned counsel states that the petitioner has sent representation Annexure P/10 dated 11.08.2020 to respondent No. 2 besides representation dated 13.08.2020 via email to respondent Nos. 3, but no decision has been taken on the same till date and in the circumstances the petitioner would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 and 3 to consider and decide the claim as made in representation Annexure P/10 dated 11.08.2020 and representation Annexure P/11 dated 13.08.2020, in accordance with law including policy Annexure P/5 dated 04.03.2020, as expeditiously as possible.

4. Notice of motion to respondent Nos.2 and 3 only.
5. Mr. Vivek Chauhan, Addl. AG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.2 and 3, and states that he has no objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.
6. Accordingly, in view of the statement of learned counsel for the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the controversy or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent Nos.2 and 3 to consider and decide representation Annexure P/10 dated 11.08.2020 and Annexure P/11 dated 13.08.2020, in accordance with law, after taking into account all aspects of the matter including policy Annexure P/5 dated 04.03.2020, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
7. Writ petition disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
