Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to respondent Nos. 1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondent Nos. 4 to 7 and taken appropriate legal action against them.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has placed on record photocopy of the MLR of all the three petitioners to submit that they were given injuries by the private respondents/accused persons despite the fact that a cognizable offence is made out from the perusal of the complaint given by the petitioners as well as the MLR, the police is not taking any action against the private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has further submitted that the petitioners have given a complaint 15.05.2019 (Annexure P-1) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar, however, no action has been taken so far.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the petitioners will feel satisfied, at this stage, if a direction is issued to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar to look into the grievances of the

petitioners and take appropriate action on their aforesaid complaint in accordance with law.

In view of the limited prayer of the petitioners, this petition is disposed of.

The Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar/respondent No. 2 is directed to look into the aforesaid complaint as well as MLR of the petitioners and take appropriate action in accordance with law in view of the judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court rendered in ***Lalita Kumari vs. State of U.P. and others, 2013 (4) R.C.R. (Criminal) 979.***

Let the needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
