This writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for directing respondent No.2 to 4 to provide immediate protection of life and liberty to the petitioners. It is claimed that the life and liberty of the petitioners is in imminent danger at the hands of various religious and political organizations.

On 14.09.2020, learned counsel appearing for the State of Punjab, has made a statement that whenever petitioner No.1 visits any area falling within the State of Punjab, he shall be provided with two personal security officers.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he would have no objection to the disposal of the writ petition in terms of the statement

made by learned counsel for the State on 14.09.2020, already noticed above.

Mr. IPS Doabia, Addl. A.G. Punjab submits that as of now, keeping in view the threat perceptions, petitioner No.1 shall be provided with two personal security officers as and when he visits the area falling in the State of Punjab. However, he prays that whenever considered appropriate, the State functionaries be permitted to re examine the threat perception after associating the petitioner and accordingly take fresh decision.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and the limited prayer made by the petitioners, the writ petition is disposed of accordingly.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are disposed of in view of the above-stated order.
