The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.235 dated 07.08.2020 registered under Section 20 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Sirhind, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

On 24.09.2020, following order was passed by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court:-

“Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the prosecution case itself, the recovery of 08 Kg. Ganja i.e. less than commercial was effected from co-accused, namely, Lakhan and not from the petitioner.

Learned State Counsel wishes to verify the pendency

of criminal case(s) against the petitioner.

On his request, adjourned to 10.12.2020.

In the meanwhile, petitioner will join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit him to interim bail in the present case till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Kuldeep Singh admitted the aforesaid fact and submitted that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation of the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 24.09.2020 is made absolute. Petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
