The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure by the petitioner, seeking regular bail in case FIR No.907 dated 25.08.2019, under Section 365 of the IPC (Sections 370(1), 370 (4) and 34 of the IPC, Section 12 of the POCSO Act & Sections 3(1)(r)(s)(w) (i), 3(2)(v)(va) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act added later on), registered at Police Station City Thanesar, District Kurukshetra, Haryana.

2. The petitioner, who is a woman, has remained in detention in the present case since 26.08.2019. After completion of investigation, challan against her has already been submitted.

3. The main accused Ajit Singh has already been granted regular bail by this Court in CRM-M-1071-2020 on 20.08.2020.

4. The detailed reasons which were taken into account while granting bail to the said accused, as contained in Paras No.2, 3 and 4 of the relevant order (Annexure P-7), are fully applicable to the present petitioner as well.

5. As such, considering the long detention undergone by the petitioner and without commenting any further on the merits of the present case as a whole as also considering the fact that the trial is likely to take its own substantial time to complete in view of the ongoing COVID-19 Pandemic, the prayer of the petitioner for releasing him on regular bail is allowed and he is ordered to be released on bail, subject to the appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
