1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner would be satisfied if the revision petition is disposed of by directing the learned Civil Judge (Sr. Division), Sangrur, to consider and decide application No.CM-103-2019, in Civil Suit No.CS-8533-2013, titled as Ravinder Kaur vs. Avinder Singh and another, filed under Order 9 Rule 9 of CPC, in a time bound manner. Learned counsel further states that the aforementioned case which was pending before the learned Civil Judge (Sr. Division), Sangrur, has been ordered to be placed before the Learned District Judge, Sangrur, on 08.09.2020, for being listed before another Court and that in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied if the learned trial court is directed to consider and decide the application, under Order 9 Rule 9 of CPC, expeditiously on transfer of the case by the learned District Judge, Sangrur.

3. Without commenting upon the merits of the controversy or the

entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the revision petition is disposed of by directing the learned trial Court to consider and decide the application under Order 9 Rule 9 of the CPC, in accordance with law, after taking into account all aspects of the matter, as expeditiously as possible after listing of the case.

4. Revision petition disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
