Case taken up through video conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, he would be satisfied if the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to take a decision on representation dated 21.01.2020 (Annexure P-10), submitted on behalf of the petitioner.

I find the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner to be reasonable.

Accordingly, at this stage, without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3- Central Board of School Education, Sector-5, Panchkula to take a decision on representation dated 21.01.2020 (Annexure P-10), submitted on behalf of the petitioner by passing a speaking order and after affording opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, preferably within one month from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

Needless to add that the decision so taken be communicated to the petitioner and if the decision is not to the satisfaction of the petitioner, he would be at liberty to challenge the same, in accordance with law.
