Challenge in this writ petition was to the letter dated 26.11.2018 whereby the Punjab National Bank sought to commence a *de novo* inquiry in relation to the disciplinary proceedings initiated against the petitioner.

While so, Mr. Saurav Verma, learned counsel appearing for the Bank, would inform this Court, on the strength of the letter dated 29.2.2020 addressed to him by the Circle Head of the Bank at its Circle Office, Amritsar, that the impugned letter dated 26.11.2018 would be withdrawn. A copy of the said letter is placed on record.

In the light of the Bank choosing to withdraw the impugned letter dated 26.11.2018, the cause in this writ petition does not survive for consideration on merits. The writ petition is accordingly disposed of as infructuous, leaving it open to the Bank to take appropriate action in accordance with law.
