The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.160 dated 28.07.2020 registered under Sections 420, 465, 468 IPC at Police Station City Rajpura, District Patiala.

On 04.09.2020, following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR pertains to the agreement to sell allegedly executed in the year 2014 and, therefore, the dispute is purely of civil nature. According to him, the FIR has been lodged belatedly to falsely implicate the petitioner and, therefore, his custodial interrogation may not be necessary.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
