All cases listed today have been taken up for hearing by way of video conferencing because of the situation existing due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'anticipatory bail', upon FIR no.350, dated 11.06.2019, having been registered at Police Station Sector 10-A, Gurugram, District Gurugram, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 323, 324, 506 read with Section 34 of the IPC, with Section 307 of the IPC added later.

Though learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has not been attributed any active role in the occurrence, with the knife blow allegedly having been given by his brother, i.e. Sumit, however as per the FIR at least the petitioner and his brother both accosted the complainant, with earlier a knife blow having been given by the petitioners' brother to the complainant on his

arm and thereafter, upon him escaping at that point, the petitioner having caught hold of the complainant with his brother having then given a knife blow in his stomach.

Consequently, in view of the contents of the FIR, I do not consider this case where anticipatory bail can be granted to the petitioner.

Therefore, this petition is dismissed.

However, naturally, nothing stated hereinabove shall be taken to be an observation on the actual merits of the case but only in the context of a petition filed under the provisions of Section 438 of the Cr.P.C.
