The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing in the light of the pandemic COVID-19 situation and as per instructions.

Learned State counsel informs that the order dated 18.11.2019 (Annexure P-1) was passed in CWP-33258-2019, due to the apprehension of life and liberty at the hands of one Narinder Singh, who has since died.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner states that family of the deceased is in possession of country-made arms and the threat from the family members of the deceased still persists. The petitioner has moved a representation to the State authorities in this regard, however, he does not have a copy thereof.

As the person from whom the petitioner apprehended threat to his life and liberty has died, therefore, the very cause of action does not survive.

However, if the petitioner feels that his life and liberty is still threatened, he may represent to the State authorities as per law.
