The matter has been taken up through video conferencing in the light of COVID-19 pandemic.

In the present petition, the petitioners have asserted about threat to their lives and liberty at the instance of private respondent nos. 5 to 8 as evident from the contents of the petition. Respondent no.5 Raman Kaur is wife of petitioner no.2 Raja Singh, respondent nos. 6 and 7 Inder Singh and Shanker Singh are sons of petitioner no.2, respondent no.8 Kuldip Singh is stated to be son-in-law of petitioner no.2. There appears to be a dispute between the petitioners and the respondents. Even injuries were caused to petitioner no.1 allegedly by the private respondents on 27.06.2019. Apprehending danger to their lives and liberty, the petitioners have filed representation dated 29.07.2020, copy whereof is Annexure P1.

However, at this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners states that he shall file similar representation as Annexure P-1 before respondent No.3- The Senior Superintendent of Police, District Sri Mukatsar and the petitioners shall be satisfied, if a direction is given to respondent no.3 to decide the same within a period of four weeks.

Notice of motion.

The offer so made by learned counsel for the petitioners is also acceptable to Mr. Sukhbeer Singh, AAG, Punjab, who has appeared on behalf of the respondents-State.

In view of the same, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioners to file a representation having similar contents as Annexure P-1, which has been addressed to DGP, Punjab, to respondent no.3-the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Sri Mukatsar, within a period of one week and thereafter, respondent no.3 shall decide the same, in accordance with law (if any so filed by the petitioners) within a period of four weeks thereafter by giving an opportunity of hearing to the petitioners.
