The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.67 dated 02.08.2020 registered under Sections 376(2)(n), 506, 328, 354-A, 323/34 IPC at Women Police Station Manesar, District Gurugram.

Vide order dated 03.09.2020, notice of motion was issued. Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that the complainant initially joined the petitioner as an employee in his business and later on has become the partner. They lived in

live-in relationship for about 5 years. On account of some money dispute, FIR came to be registered.

On oral request of learned counsel for the petitioner, the complainant was ordered to be impleaded as party respondent No.2 vide order dated 03.09.2020.

As per office report, service is complete but none has appeared on behalf of the complainant/respondent No.2.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in compliance of order dated 03.09.2020, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Sunita, admitted the aforesaid fact and submitted that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation of the case.

In view of above, the interim order dated 03.09.2020 is made absolute. Petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
