The petitioner is aggrieved because no FIR has been registered against the private respondents although they trespassed into her house and attacked her as well as her family members on 10.01.2020. Instead family members of the petitioner have been named as accused in FIR No. 08 dated 17.01.2020 registered under Sections 323, 325, 506, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Sadar Banga. Even a representation dated 14.02.2020 (Annexure P-3) has not yielded any result.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 5 only.

Mr. Ajay Pal Singh Gill, DAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and waives service.

In view of nature of the order being passed there is no necessity to file a written statement nor is it necessary to serve the private respondents.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 4 to objectively consider representation dated 14.02.2020 (Annexure P-3) and pass an appropriate speaking order thereupon in accordance with law within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
