Counsel for the State of Haryana, on instructions, would inform that nothing is under consideration of the Government qua treating 'Sansi' caste as Scheduled Tribe in place of Scheduled Caste. However, he would inform that as per allegations raised by the petitioners, representation dated 01.02.2020 (Annexure P13) has been made by All India De-notified and Nomadic Tribes Welfare Sangh (Regd.) Karnal for the same relief as has been claimed in the writ petition. He would pray that petition may be disposed of with direction to dispose of the aforesaid representation.

Counsel for the petitioners would state that the writ petition may be disposed of in view of submissions made by counsel for the State of

Haryana.

Without examining merits of the case, the present petition stands disposed of. In case the petitioners file a representation raising the issues as have been culled out in the writ petition, within a period of fifteen days and ensure its receipt by office of the Chief Secretary, Government of Haryana, the same shall be considered and decided by the said authority within a period of forty five days from the date of its receipt.
