The first regular bail application was dismissed. This is the second bail application for interim bail. The same has been filed on the ground that the wife of the petitioner is suffering from heart ailment and requires surgery.

Learned counsel for the petitioner had placed on record the medical record of the ailment being suffered by the wife of the petitioner, Baljit Kaur. Nevertheless, this Court directed the wife of the petitioner to appear before the Head of Cardiology Department, Government Medical College and Hospital, Sector 32, Chandigarh for examining the report of Baljit Kaur and to confirm as to whether the wife of the petitioner requires surgery or not. Report of Prof. (Dr.) Sreenivas Reddy, Professor & Head, Department of Cardiology, Government Medical College and Hospital, Sector 32, Chandigarh dated 10.10.2020 has been received. Operative part of the same reads as under:-

“....The Echocardiography revealed Regional wall motion abnormality in LAD territory with Left Ventricular ejection fraction of 55-60%. Her blood sugars were uncontrolled (>300

mg by glucometer) for which medicines have been adjusted and also advised to get endocrinology consultation for optimization of treatment for control of blood sugars.

In view of her recurrent symptoms despite optimal medical therapy she has been advised Coronary Angiography after control of blood sugar and further treatment can be suggested accordingly. For the above investigations/tests to contact the treating doctors to telemedicine OPD (9517771750).”

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that she had already been advised surgery and they wish to undergo the surgery at Neelam Hospital at Banur. It is further stated that the surgery is fixed for 25.10.2020.

Taking into account the facts and circumstances of the present case, interim bail is granted to the petitioner for two months subject to his furnishing of two sureties of ₹ 1 lac each and both sureties will be of close family members to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

The petitioner shall surrender on 14.12.2020.

Disposed of as above.
