With the consent of learned counsel for both the parties, the matter is being taken up and heard via video conferencing.

The petitioner has filed this petition against the order of termination of contract. Apparently there is a disputes redressal mechanism contained in para-24 of the contract. The petitioner has to invoke the same and thereafter if so required take up all the remedies available to him under the common law as the dispute between the parties is purely contractual.

In the circumstances, the petition is disposed of granting liberty to the petitioner to invoke the dispute resolution clause and to avail all other remedies available to him under law.
