Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the son of the petitioner is 100% mentally challenged and, therefore, in the event of his transfer, he would be put to immense hardship. He has referred to the representation (Annexure P7) sent by him to the respondents on 29.08.2020 for exempting him from the transfer drive in terms of the transfer policy. He also contends that the respondents/competent authority may be directed to consider and decide his representation expeditiously.

Issue notice to the respondents.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Sharad Aggarwal, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to the Administrative Secretary, Excise and Taxation Department, Government of Haryana (respondent No.2)/competent authority to consider and decide the

representation (Annexure P7) of the petitioner sympathetically in accordance with the transfer policy by passing a speaking order within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
