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Heard. For the reasons mentioned in the application, delay of 72 days in filing the review application is condoned. Application stands disposed of.

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It is settled law that the power of review can be invoked only in cases where there is some apparent or glaring mistake evident faced with the record. In the instant case, no such glaring or apparent mistake is evident or pointed out. On the contrary, learned counsel for the applicant seeks to argue the case afresh which is not permissible in review proceedings. This Court has considered all the issues raised in the petition as well as those sought to be raised in the application for review.

There is no glaring mistake apparent on the face of record to review the order dated 05.12.2019. Accordingly, the review application stands dismissed.
