The present criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has contended that the petitioners are major and have solemnized their marriage on 31.08.2020 against the wishes of their parents and relatives. They are receiving serious threats and apprehend grave danger to their life and liberty at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 8.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Vishlesh Kumar, states that statement of petitioner No.1 was recorded on 05.10.2020 and petitioner No.2 on 24.09.2020. The statements of the private respondents were also recorded on 25.09.2020 and as per the statements recorded there is no threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners.

In view of the statement made by the leaned State counsel,
no further orders are required to be passed in the present case inasmuch
as the apprehension of the petitioners stands addressed.

The petition is disposed off accordingly.
