The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing DDR No. 13 dated 07.08.2017 registered under Sections 307, 148, 149, 323, 324 and 506 IPC and Sections 25 & 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 in FIR No. 122 dated 07.08.2017 under Sections 307, 506, 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25, 27, 54, 59 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Kamboj, District Amritsar Rural.

On 07.09.2020, following order was passed by this Court:-

"The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the

petitioners are attributed simple injuries on the person of complainant-Palwinder Pal. Petitioner No.1 is alleged to have inflicted dang blow on the head of the complainant-Palwinder Pal. Petitioner No.2 is alleged to have given rod blow on the head of the complainant. Palwinder Pal-complainant received total six injuries on his person and all the injuries have been declared to be simple in nature. Co-accused, namely, Sarup Singh @ Suba and Jaspal Singh @ Bhala Mehra have been granted interim bail by this Court in CRM-M-22759 of 2020 vide order dated 14.08.2020. Co-accused namely Jagroop Singh and Sawinder Singh @ Tany have also been granted interim bail by this Court vide order dated 27.08.2020 passed in CRMM- 24589 of 2020.

Notice of motion for 05.10.2020.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Ramdeep Partap Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.

In the meanwhile, petitioners are directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 12.09.2020 at 11.00 a.m. and in the event of their arrest, they shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, subject to their furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioners shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

List along with CRM-M No. 22759 of 2020.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that in compliance of the aforesaid order, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Shish Pal admitted the aforesaid fact and submitted that the petitioners are no more required for further investigation of the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order

dated 07.09.2020 is made absolute. However, petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
