The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

CRM-21784-2020

The present application has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking exemption from filing original Affidavit executed by the petitioner in support of petition and original Power of Attorney of the petitioner.

Prayer of exemption on account of Covid-19 is accepted with the condition that the petitioner shall deposit the required documents within a period of one month, when the situation becomes normal from the Covid-19 effect.

Application stands disposed of.

CRM-M No.25903 of 2020

The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.0016 dated 15.01.2020 under Sections 406/506 IPC registered at Police Station Rai, District Sonapat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 07.10.2020 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required at this stage.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Pawan, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 07.10.2020 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
