This criminal writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ specially in the nature of Habeas Corpus to raid the premises of the respondent Nos. 4 to 6 and to recover the detinue 'Ramandeep Kaur' sister of the petitioner from the illegal confinement of respondent Nos. 4 to 7.

On 29.05.2019, the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court directed respondent No. 3-Station House Officer to enquire as to whether detinue Ramandeep Kaur has been confined illegally against her wishes by the private respondents. As per the affidavit of SHO dated 17.08.2019, the marriage of the detneue was solemnized with Jatinder Singh on 11.05.2019 and they approached the High Court and protection was

granted on 14.05.2019. The statement of detenue was recorded that she is residing happily with her husband Jatinder Singh.

Learned State counsel states that the present Habeas petition has been filed by Gurjant Singh who is the brother of the detenue on 24.05.2019 and FIR was registered on the complaint of Lovepreet Singh-brother of the detenue and cancellation report has been filed.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent Nos. 4 and 5 has also stated that detenue is happily residing with her husband, no further action is called for.

Consequently, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
