With the consent of learned counsel for both the parties, the matter is being taken up and heard via video conferencing.

The petitioners have filed this petition being aggrieved by the tender notice issued by the respondent-authorities for allotting the works of cleanliness and maintenance of toilets and urinals falling under 113 Market Committees in the State of Haryana. The petitioners, who are at present executing the aforesaid works in various market committees, have challenged the same firstly on the ground that the market committees have already granted them extension for executing the aforesaid works for a period beyond January, 2021 as well as on the ground that the terms and conditions of the tender are unreasonable.

Learned Additional Advocate General appearing for the State of Haryana submits that the extensions granted by the market committees in favour of the petitioners and others, on their own and on the previous terms and conditions, are required to be examined and dealt with by the respondent authorities. And thus treating the present petition as representation, the respondents shall decide the issue as early as possible before proceeding further with the tender proceedings.

In view of the statement made by learned Additional Advocate General appearing for the State of Haryana and in terms thereof, the petition filed by the petitioners stands disposed of.
