The petitioner is aggrieved because intimation has already been given to the police regarding the illegal acts committed by respondents No. 4 and 5 but no FIR has been registered. The said persons allegedly caused injuries, out raged her modesty and snatched a sum of Rs. 20,000/-. A detailed representation dated 10.07.2020 (Annexure P-2) has been submitted but no action has been taken thereupon till date.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 only.

Mr. Ajay Pal Singh Gill, DAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and waives service.

In view of nature of the order being passed there is no necessity to file a written statement nor is it necessary to serve the private respondents.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to objectively consider representation dated 10.07.2020 (Annexure P-2) and pass an appropriate speaking order thereupon in accordance with law within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
