(The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.)

The petitioners, claiming themselves to be aged about 21 and 27 years respectively, have approached this Court seeking protection of their life and liberty on the averments that the petitioners, being major, performed marriage on 31.08.2020 at Prachin Guga Mari Rama Krishna Mandir, Sector 19, Chandigarh, as per Hindu rites and ceremonies against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 6 and the petitioners are apprehending threat to their life and liberty at their instance.

This Court vide order dated 03.09.2020 while issuing notice of motion had directed respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur to look into the grievances of the petitioners as set out in the petition and also expressed in the representation dated 31.08.2020 (Annexure P-5) and to take appropriate action for protection of their life and liberty as may be warranted by the

circumstances.

However, no action taken report has been filed by respondent No.2 Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur.

As per office report, notices to respondents No.4 to 6 could not be issued as process fee was not filed.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that now the petitioners do not have any apprehension of danger to their life and liberty and the petitioners do not want to continue with the present petition and the same may be dismissed as withdrawn.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
