This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No. 66 dated 07.07.2020 under Sections 326, 324, 452, 148 and 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (lateron Section 307 IPC was added) registered at Police Station Ghuman Kalan, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the State has sent medical legal report on whatsapp group which is taken on record. As per this report, out of the total 12 injuries, injury No. 3, which has been attributed to the present petitioner, is on the middle of left upper arm and is described as incised wound 13X2 c.m. and the injury is simple in nature. He further states that as per the FIR (Annexure P-1) the petitioner Ranjit Singh was armed with *kirpan* and gave one *kirpan* blow which hit on the left shoulder of the complainant-Rana Bhupinder Singh.

Learned counsel for the complainant has vehemently opposed the bail application of the petitioner on the grounds that this is the second application of the petitioner and the bail application of his co-accused

Gursharan Singh has been dismissed vide order dated 11.08.2020 passed in CRM-M-21073-2020.

Learned counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Palwinder Singh submits that investigation is still going on.

Keeping in view that 12 injuries were caused by group of persons by entering in the house of the complainant and the effect of attack on the complainant with sharp edged weapon by all the accused was dangerous to life, the bail application is dismissed.
