In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.4-Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka, District Fazilka, to look into and decide representation dated 08.08.2020 (Annexure P/6) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within eight weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
